

- 1 Post Flood Mitigation Trailer
- 1 Support/Tow Vehicle
- All trailers come with a Team Leader
- FN crews will be trained and utilized to support their communities.
- Trailers will be staged in areas around the province as required.



Evacuation & Emergency Support Services (ESS)





Transition to Recovery



- 1. Re-entry to community and transition to recovery
- 2. Rapid Damage Assessments (RDA)
- 3. Request Disaster Financial Assistance & any Financial Support from Indigenous Services Canada
- 4. Resumption of Essential Services
- 5. Other Recovery (food security, restore utilities)
- 6. Offer mental health services to community members
- 7. Obtain EMCR Funding for After Action Review (AAR)
